Founding member retires

Alan Barnett retired from the Club this year and has moved to Ormskirk to be near his daughter.



Alan and Jean, [Jean died in 2014] were founding members of the club and were members of the first committee that was held in March 1977. Between them, Alan and Jean established the jobs of Club Secretary and Membership Secretary and undertook these for nearly twenty years.

RYA Welsh Zone Championships

The RYA Welsh Zone Championships took place at Cardiff Bay Yacht Club on the weekend of 24th and 25th September. Four Brenig juniors were among the 100+young sailors who took part in the event, and all achieved some fabulous results. Brother and sister **Tyler and Tasmyn Green** both put in impressive performances in the 35-strong Optimist main fleet. Tyler posted a consistent set of top 5 results to finish 3rd overall, while his younger sister finished consistently in the top 10 to claim 6th overall and 2nd girl.

After only a few months in the Topper 5.3 rig, **Benjamin Jukes-Bennett** was competing in the Topper main fleet of 33 boats, finishing an impressive 9th overall.

The club had it's first windsurfing medal with **Alexander Hopkins** claiming Bronze place (3rd overall) in the Bic Techno 6.8.
